

Rallyball Questions

How many weeks is Rallyball?

Rallyball will run through the month of May. Some schools will continue through the first week of June if there is a cancellation (ex. Memorial Day, school carnival...). **Please check the website for your schools schedule at www.grandtraversetennis.com. Click on the Rallyball link in blue on the homepage.**

How long is a match?

Matches will be 12-15 minutes long, depending on how many teams are at your school

When do we get our t-shirts?

T-shirts will be ordered the first week of the league and should arrive within 10 days of ordering. You will receive your shirt at your school unless told otherwise. It would be cool to wear your Rallyball t-shirt to school the day of the league too!

How is the championship team determined at each school?

The team with the most points at the end of the session will be the school champion. Points are determined on win/loss/tie

What are the tickets for?

You will be awarded tickets for attendance, special activities and for earning miles on the mileage chart. The tickets will then go into a barrel the day of the city championships and prizes will be awarded to those who's name gets drawn (winners will be posted on the website at: **www.grandtraversetennis.com. Click on the Rallyball link in blue on the homepage.**

What do we do with the tickets?

Make sure you put your name (legibly) on each ticket and your phone number. Tear **ALL** of the tickets apart and return to your coaches on the last day of the league, or you can bring them to the city championships **(torn apart into individual tickets with your name and phone number on them) and give them to the lead coach at your site**

Where are the city championships?

The city championships will be held at 2-3 different sites on Saturday June 6th from 10 AM – 12 Noon. Sites will be West Senior High, West Middle School, East Middle School and Central High School. You can find out what site your team is supposed to report to by going to the website at **www.grandtraversetennis.com. Click on the Rallyball link in blue on the homepage.**

How do the city championships work?

Teams that have the best record at their school will all go to one site to compete for the city championship crown. The top 2 teams will move on to the Northern Michigan Championships in August.

All other teams will report to other sites to compete against other schools of the same age, but will not be competing for the city championship crown.
